



Application method

Textile pad method

This cleaning procedure is suitable for the interim cleaning of all water-resistant carpets that can withstand mechanical treatment. It is ideal for short-piled, cut-pile carpets.



Step 1: Check suitability for cleaning

Soak white cotton cloth in detergent and place on an inconspicuous part of the carpet (weigh down with canister if needed). Leave for approx. 15 minutes.

If the cloth absorbs the colour from the carpet:

No wet cleaning! Flooring not colour-fast.

If the carpet can be lifted from the surface below:

No wet cleaning! Adhesive not water-resistant.

Black, brown stains on the cloth and carpet:

No wet cleaning! Conductive adhesive.



Step 2: Vacuum the flooring

Thoroughly vacuum or brush the carpet. Check the flooring for damage. Ladders, bulges, etc.



Step 3: Dose, prepare ready-to-use solution

First add water, then add the correct amount of detergent, following the dosage instructions on the label. Always use cold water!

Follow operating instructions. Wear personal protective equipment.

Step 4: Clean with textile pad

Spray textile pad with cleaning solution and place under the rotary floor machine's pad holder. Pre-spray approx. 5–15 m² of carpet area with cleaning solution. Run machine over the sprayed area in even, overlapping strokes until the dirt has been removed. Turn over or replace pads regularly.



Step 5: Fluff up carpet pile

Use a soft, clean scrubber to fluff up the pile of cut-pile floorings. Then leave carpet to dry.



Step 6: Clean the devices

Clean machines and devices with a damp cloth. Check cable for damage.
