



Routine cleaning (surface cleaning)



Blue cloth

General surfaces, tables, doors, window sills, etc.





Yellow cloth

Mirrors, wash basins, shelves, partition walls, etc.





Red cloth

Toilets, urinals, splash zones





Green cloth

Kitchen areas, disinfection



Folding method



Folding the cloth twice creates 8 working areas. This allows you to clean eight times without having to rinse the cloth!





Routine cleaning (surface cleaning)







Step 1: Dose and prepare ready-to-use solution

First add water, then add the correct amount of detergent, following the dosage instructions on the label. Always use cold water!





Routine cleaning (surface cleaning)



Step 2: Rinse and fold the cloth

Rinse the cloth in cleaning solution and wring out. Fold cloth as described. The folding method creates 8 working areas to use before the cloth needs to be rinsed out again.



Step 3: Clean the surfaces systematically

Clean the surfaces systematically using the folded cloth. Turn the dirty side of the cloth over to use a clean side. Rinse the cloth in a bucket if necessary. Replace the cleaning solution if necessary.



Step 4: Clean tools

Empty and rinse out the bucket after finishing work. Cloths should be washed with laundry.





Step 1: Dose and prepare ready-to-use solution

Step 2: Fold cloth and spray on foam

Fold cloth and spray on foam. Hold the cloth close to the foam spray bottle.



Step 3: Clean the surfaces systematically

Clean the surfaces systematically using the folded cloth. Turn the dirty side of the cloth over to use a clean side. Rinse the cloth in a bucket if necessary. Replace the cleaning solution if necessary.



Step 4: Clean tools

Empty and rinse out the bucket after finishing work. Cloths should be washed with laundry.





Routine cleaning (surface cleaning)

Preparing cleaning cloths



Rinse cloths manually

Place cloths in box. Prepare cleaning solution into a measuring cup and pour over the specified amount of cleaning solution.



Semi-automated preparation of cloths

Place cloths in box. Place box under the dosing unit discharge hose. Press the start button and submerge cloths in cleaning solution.





Routine cleaning (surface cleaning)



ProMop System

Open laundry machine and place the prepared cloths in the corresponding boxes.



Step 1: Clean the surfaces systematically

Clean the surfaces systematically using the folded cloth. Turn the dirty side of the cloth over to use a clean side. Rinse the cloth in a bucket if necessary. Replace the cleaning solution if necessary.
